

### **Agreed Board of Management Report**

11<sup>th</sup> May, 2022

- The Board wishes to inform the school community that it has conducted the annual review of our Child Safeguarding Statement/Risk Assessment and Anti-Bullying Policy and Procedures.
- The school's 'Supervision' and 'School Tours and Outings' policies were reviewed and ratified by the Board.
- Staff undertook First Aid and Defibrillator training on 23<sup>rd</sup> March with STAC Training Group. It was a very informative and worthwhile evening.
- The Board of Management has granted a request from Ms. Elaine Duddy to host hold a Campa Samhradh (Summer Irish Camp) on the school grounds for the first week of the summer holidays.
- The school will purchase the 'Caint is Comhrá' scheme from CJ Fallon for the teaching of Irish from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Class. It will be introduced from September 2022.
- As our new school building was fully funded and built by the Department of Education, a percentage of the overall cost of the build is given by the DES towards an art installation(s). The board will now commence the first stage of this 'Percent for Art' scheme where we will seek expressions of interest from artists. A shortlisting and consultation process will take place during the remaining parts of the process.
- The school will order equipment and resources in line with a new tranche of grant money received for I.T. The staff prioritisation highlighted the need for two new interactive white boards, visualisers, a green screen, portable mice and keyboards. These will be procured and ordered in the coming weeks.
